- Main Roads history early 20's
- Stewardship role MR is not the owner
- Legal access water, sewerage, stormwater, gas, electricity and telecommunications


- Rural road agency → leading-edge road agency and government agency

- Injection of innovation is critical






Coutt's Crossing near Grafton NSW - Wagners CFT Toowoomba February 2003
