This work is a first of its kind and CRC for *Construction Innovation* value Scott's significant contribution.

Marty Burgess Faculty Director, Trades & Technology who was also at the meeting supported the involvement of staff in industry projects. "Scott was seconded to this position and it is great that these opportunities are available to our staff – it helps expand their knowledge base and bring back what they have learnt to the classroom, so our students also benefit".
