he Cooperative Research Centre (CRC) for Construction Innovation has released its vision for the future of the property and construction industry, following consultation with industry leaders and members across Australia.

Its report, Construction 2020 — A Vision for Australia 's Property and Construction Industry, documents a framework within which Australia can set a research agenda to position itself to perform more competitively at an international level.

As a result of the process, nine key themes emerged, with an overarching vision,
Australian leadership in research and innovation, being central to delivering the other eight. They include:

- Environmentally sustainable construction;
- Meeting client needs;

- Improved business environment;
- Welfare and improvement of the labour force;
- Information and communication technologies for construction;
- Virtual prototyping for design, manufacture and operation;
- Off-site manufacture; and

Following launch of the report in Canberra in late June, the CRC conducted a nation-wide series of workshops in June and July, where it shared the findings with members of the property and construction industries, and sought input to establish a robust and effective action and research agenda for the future of the industry.
