Local Manager Wins Project Management Award

Development Manager of the Cooperative Research Centre for *Construction Innovation*, Peter Scuderi has taken out the Project Director Category of the Project Management Achievement Awards.

The CRC for *Construction Innovation* is a national research, development and implementation centre focused on the needs of the property, design, construction and facility management sectors. Peter directs the CRC's research program that comprises 49 leading edge projects with a total budget of \$48 million.
